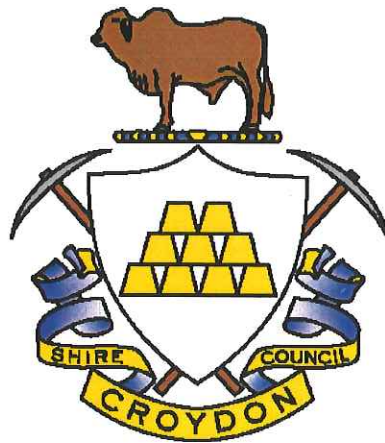

(STOCK ON RESERVES)**

This Local Law Policy is to be read with Local Law No.9 (Stock on Reserves).

Made by Council resolution on 17 August 2000.

1. Citation

This local law policy may be cited as Local Law Policy No.9 (Stock on Reserves).

2. Objects

The objects of this local law policy are to provide detailed information called upon by Local Law No.9 (Stock on Reserves):

- (a) to regulate the depasturing of stock on reserves;
- (b) to protect the community, stock and other animals against risk or injury.

3. Definitions

"Inner Town Common" means the fenced area surrounding the Township of Croydon.

4. Local Law - Section 3 - Definitions

For the purposes of Section 3 of the Local Law the definition of "stock" means cattle, horses (except for stallions), goats and pigs.

5. Local Law - Section 6 - Designation of Stock on Reserve

For the purposes of Section 6 of the Local Law the land described as follows is designated a stock reserve:

- (a) Lot 953 on R 952 C3591 County of Surrey Parish of Croydon, excluding the Inner Town Common.

6. Local Law - Section 8 - Name of Stock Reserve

For the purposes of Section 8 of the Local Law the stock reserve described as Lot 953 R 952 C 3591 shall be named the "Outer Town Common".

7. Local Law - Section 10 - Restriction on Permit

- (1) For the purposes of Section 10(a) of the Local Law the following maximum number of head of stock per permit is prescribed:
 - (a) Horses - 10
 - (b) Cattle - 10
 - (c) Goats - 200
- (2) For the purposes of Section 10(b) of the Local Law a maximum area of 6m by 6m is prescribed for each permit issued for pigs.
- (3) For the purposes of Section 10(c) of the Local Law a maximum of one permit per type of stock may be held by one person.

8. Local Law - Section 12(3) - Conditions of Permit

For the purposes of Section 12(3) of the Local Law the following conditions may be imposed in a permit:

- (a) On 30 June of each year, Permits are to be renewed;
- (b) On 30 June of each year a copy of the stock return must be produced by the permit holder to local government;
- (c) Twenty four (24) hours notice must be provided to local government where the permit holder intends to muster, drive or work stock on the stock reserve;
- (d) The stock must be wormed and free from disease before entering the stock reserve;
- (e) The stock must display an identifying tag or fire brand that is consistent with the identifying tag or fire brand detailed in the permit application;
- (f) Where an identifying tag becomes worn, lost or unreadable the holder of the permit must replace the identification tag or fire brand with an identification tag or fire brand of the same type;
- (g) A holder of a permit must notify local government when an identifying tag or fire brand is altered or changed.

9. Local Law - Section 14

For the purposes of Section 14 of the Local Law the number of stock on the stock reserve is limited as follows:

- (a) Horses - 50;
- (b) Cattle - 50;
- (c) Goats - 1000.
