Restricted Use of Croydon Water Supply from 28 September 2020

Boil Water Alert to continue until further notice

Council has been able to carry out some repairs to the filters at the Water Treatment Plant, however there is still more work to be done. To ensure there is no loss of water supply to the community it is necessary to restrict use of water until further notice.

Use of sprinklers, hand held hosing or unattended hoses is not permitted. No external hosing of houses, vehicles, plant or equipment is permitted.

Council advises all residents in Croydon to continue to boil their tap water used for drinking until further notice following problems being experienced to the filters at the Water Treatment Plant and possible contamination affecting the Croydon water supply.

Council staff are working to fix the problems - your cooperation is requested until the necessary works are completed.
