WATER/SERVICE UTILITIES OFFICER

Applications are invited for the position of Water/Service Utilities Officer within Croydon Shire Council.

This position is permanent, full time. Reporting to the Works Manager, you will be responsible for the safe and effective operation of the towns water treatment plant, as well as carrying out septic system waste management, water repairs and operational maintenance to the community swimming pool and Caravan Park swimming pool.

To be successful in this role you must be able to provide a level of expertise in the operation and maintenance of the water supply scheme as well as:

- A comprehensive knowledge of and ability to operate a Direct Filtration Package Water Treatment Plant with a 1ML per day capacity;
- Detailed knowledge of procedures and operations of water and wastewater activities as they relate to Local Government; and
- Ability to operate under limited direction and supervision.
